

Required for the 341 Meeting

At the meeting of creditors, each individual debtor must present original government-issued photo identification and confirmation of debtor's social security number. Any document used to confirm a debtor's identity and social security number must be an original (per 11 U.S.C § 521(h), 28 U.S.C § 586(b))

Acceptable forms of picture identification (ID) include: driver's license, U.S. government ID, State ID, student ID, passport (or current visa, if not a U.S. citizen), military ID, resident alien card, and identity card issued by a national government authority.

Acceptable forms of proof of social security number include: social security card, medical insurance card with the full social security number on it, pay stub, W-2 form, IRS Form 1099, and Social Security Administration (SSA) Statement. In the discretion of the standing trustee, copies of a W-2 Form, IRS Form 1099, or a recent payroll stub may be accepted.
